Covid Safety Q&A

Q - What Precaution is RWC taking, to keep the community safe from Covid-19?

- We are following KFL&A Guidelines for holding Religious Services.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building.
- Everyone will be expected to check in upon entry for:
 1. Recording name and phone # for Contact tracking. (Kept for 1 month at church, then destroyed)
 2. A brief screening for symptoms of Covid-19.
 3. To receive bulletin and service information (materials handled with proper hand hygiene)
- Social Distancing is required and capacity of meeting space is limited to max 50% (Max Sanctuary Capacity is 135 right now)
- Masks are to be worn at all times (except for those who are speaking or leading), face shields may be used if unable to wear a mask. **Note:** Masks must cover nose, mouth, and chin.
- We are using our normal cloth chairs, All chairs are disinfected between services
- Cleaning and disinfecting is taking place before, during, and after facility usage **Note:** Unused rooms are partitioned off.

Q - What Time are your services?

- Sunday services are at (9 am and 10:30am)

Q - Who can come to your services and do I have to RSVP if I am planning to attend?

- Services are open to anyone, of all ages.

Q - What do I do when I arrive for service?

- Upon arrival
 - Put on your mask, and sanitize your hands upon entry.
 - Check in at the welcome desk (See info above)
- We ask that you sit in your family bubble.

Q - Can I view your services from home?

- Yes - A weekly online service are available on YouTube ([YouTube.com/roblinwesleyanchurch](https://www.youtube.com/roblinwesleyanchurch)), each Sunday morning, and will be available for viewing throughout the week. Link on website and Facebook

Q - Can I Sing?

- Singing is permitted.

Q - What Precautions are you taking to protect children?

- We have kids church in the gym (ages 3-12), dismissed during service, before morning message; kids are screened again at start and family info is taken. NOTE Kids church runs under the same policies that day camps follow.
- We have an unstaffed nursery available for use if needed. Room is disinfected between use.

Q - If I want to contribute financially to the ministries of RWC, how do I do it?

- An 'offering box' for cash or cheques, available in lobby. A regularly sanitized debit machine is also available.
